ENTRY FORM

Please read the entry pack carefully. The entry form must be fully completed and returned to this office by the closing date. Entries received after this date will not be accepted.

May we remind you that your entry will only be accepted upon receipt at this office of the official entry form, together with payment of the entry fee of £100 either by cheque or credit card by the date stated above. No verbal confirmation of entry will be accepted. IF WE DO NOT RECEIVE YOUR ENTRY FORM AND FEE BY THE 15 JUNE 2007 YOU WILL NOT BE ENTERED INTO THE DRAW UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE. The draw will be performed on the morning of 18 June 2007.

Please be aware that this tournament will be run subject to a minimum number of 16 entries received. If entries fall below the required level, all entry fees will be refunded.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEES

We would remind you that your annual membership fee of £100 is now due. You will need to pay your annual membership before your entry into this event will be accepted. Please use the enclosed credit card form.

COMPETING PLAYERS

The World Professional Billiards Championship 2007 is open to all billiards members of WPBSA, together with non-members. Any non-members who enter the event must join the WPBSA as a billiards member. Please contact this office for details on billiards membership.

STRUCTURE

The tournament will commence on 18 July 2007, with the final on the 22 July 2007. All first round matches will be round robin. The top eight players will be seeded in groups, with the remaining players drawn at random.

Seeding will be based on last years results (copy enclosed) as follows:

- 1 defending champion
- 2 runner-up
- 3-4 losing semi-finalists, drawn at random
- 5-8 losing quarter-finalists, drawn at random

World ranking points will not be calculated for this season.

NORTHERN SNOOKER CENTRE OPEN 2007

Alongside our professional tournament, Northern Snooker Centre will be hosting the Northern Snooker Centre Open in association with the EABA and WPBSA. This will be a competition for the group losers (scheduling permitting also the losing quarter finalists) playing against top invited amateur players. We anticipate that the entry fee for the Open event will be approximately £15 and the prize fund will be £1,000. Entry forms will be available shortly.

As you can see from the provisional format above, the Open event will be played concurrently on the Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. The format will be confirmed after the closing date.

Northern Snooker Centre has strong links with Billiards, and is very keen to develop the sport further. We would therefore ask that you support the Open event.
