

the corner courtyard State Ranking Snooker & Billiards Championship 2013 at The Calcutta Swimming Club

Rules & Regulations

- 1. All games to be played on the tables approved by the tournament committee at The Calcutta Swimming Club.
- **2.** <u>Snooker:</u> Best of 5 frames up to the quarter finals. Semi-finals and finals to be played as a best of 7 frames.
- **3.** <u>Billiards:</u> Up to quarter finals, best of 5 frames of 100 up format up to the Quarter-finals. Semi-finals and finals to be played as a best of 7 frames.
- **4.** All matches to be played from 9 AM to 4.30 PM.
- 5. No postponement will be allowed. No grace time is allowed. Failure to reach on time will result in a 1 frame penalty. Failure to reach within 10 minutes of scheduled time will result in a forfeiture of the match. This will be enforced by the referee without the opinion of either player.
- 6. Failure to finish a match in the time allotted will require both players to resume their match the following day at 9AM or whenever the Tournament committee decides.
- 7. The tournament committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning a reason.
- **8.** The tournament committee reserves the right to change the format of the tournament, date, table and timings of the schedule matches without prior notice.
- **9.** The decision of the tournament committee, in all matters will be final.
- 10. Only proficient players need to enter the tournament.
- 11. No Entry form will be accepted without the entry fees. Entry fees have to be deposited at the club office along with the completed and signed entry form and the receipt is required to be submitted to the referee before the start of the player's first match in the tournament. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted by any other means.
- **12.** Players are requested to follow the fixtures that will be put up at the Club. No separate intimation will be given.
- **13.** Points will be awarded to the Winners, Runners Up, Semi Finalists and Quarter Finalists in both the events.
- **14.** Prizes will be given only at the prize distribution ceremony. All recipients of prizes are requested to be present to receive their prizes. No separate intimation will be given.
- **15.** To qualify for the highest break, a player must have a break of 75 and above in Snooker.
- **16.** In case of a tie for the highest break, the player who has made the break first, will be awarded the prize.
- 17. It is mandatory for players to be WBBA accredited, to participate.
- 18. Accreditation fee is Rs. 250 (One time) and annual fee is Rs. 100
- 19. The entry fee is Rs. 500 per discipline.
- 20. A strict dress code will be enforced. Trousers, single -coloured formal shirt or t-shirt with collar and formal shoes are mandatory. Jeans, Sneakers, t-shirts r without collars, sandals, slippers, patterned or striped shirts or t-shirts are not permitted.
- 21. Chewing of pan masala, pan or tobacco of any form is not permitted in the club. Any player found violating this rule will be removed from the club premises and will be removed from the tournament immediately. A player may not have any substance in his mouth while playing on the table.
