

Dr. J.D. Kohli Memorial All India Open 6 Red Snooker Tournament 2014

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. From all the entries received, 8 players with highest CSI rankings will be seeded. The balance 8 seeded players shall be last year's winner and runner up, U.P. No.1 & 2, 2 UP Junior Players and 2 committee's choice.
2. The rankings as shown on CSI site on the last date of entry shall be considered. Any changes in the ranking after that date shall not be considered.
3. In case if all the 16 seeded players are not available then the tournament committee shall select any player of its choice to be seeded.
4. The remaining entries shall play the qualifiers and 16 shall qualify for the main round.
5. All entries are accepted on first come first serve basis.
6. NO accommodations shall be provided to any player. No meals shall be provided. No other request for change will be accepted.
7. No entries shall be accepted after last date of entry.
8. Qualifiers will be played in a double elimination format.
9. Main draw shall be played first in league format and then knockout format.
10. All league matches will be best of five frames, and knockout matches best of seven (semis being best of nine & finals best of eleven).
11. The tournament committee has the right to change.
 - i) any player by any wait listed player.*
 - ii) the playing table of any match if the need is there. No objections shall be entertained.*
 - iii) the playing time of any match if the need is there. No objections shall be entertained.*
12. The decision of the referee or the chief referee shall be final. No objections shall be entertained.
13. No referee shall be provided for the qualifiers or the league matches. Players are expected to refer their own matches.
14. The tournament shall be played as per old rules of six red snooker. (Foul shall be ball in hand, snooker behind nominated ball is a foul etc.)
15. Dress code shall be semi-formal: Formal pants, Single colored shirt or collared T-Shirts and formal shoes. Any deviation shall be automatic walkover.
16. No "No Value" matches will be played.
17. All players are expected to behave like gentlemen and play the game in a sportsman fashion.
