Season Summary - 2007 / 2008

EBOS ended a very successful second full season in Jersey in May, which culminated in two extraordinary 10 shot's from Phillip Smith (Jersey), and then Matthew Sutton. The series saw five different event winners, a high



season break of **512** made by Peter Gilchrist, and paid out a total of **£13,348***1 in prize money. The first junior (U19) EBOS event was held in Prestatyn alongside the Welsh Open, which saw Michael Williams triumph and earn himself entry into this years EBOS. Further success was achieved at the end of the season by the news that EBOS have been granted direct entry (3 places) into this years **IBSF World Championships** in Bangalore. This is a major step forward for EBOS, and indeed we hope our ability to nominate to these championships from our Ranking List in future years ... watch this space ...



STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS

FOR ENTRY TO ALL EBOS EVENTS

32.

- The series is to be known as the ENGLISH-BILLIARDS OPEN SERIES (EBOS) official 'European Tour'.
- 2. All matches in EBOS tournaments will be played off levels.
- 3. The EBOS can be entered by paying a one off subscription fee of 31. £200 which covers entry to all EBOS events of the season.
- 4. There will be a minimum of 6 events in the series.
- 5. The EBOS is limited to the first 48 paid subscribers.
- 6. Closing date for entries is 31st August 2008.
- Any 6 from 8 EBOS events will count towards a season 'Order of Merit' ranking list. Prize money will be paid out to the top 8 players on the list at the end of the season.
- All subscribed players will drop their lowest 2 scoring event's from the final Ranking List.
- Guaranteed £1,300 in prize money will be paid out for the main competition at each event (plus £100 for the plate competition).

- Subject to 32 subscribed entries, and sponsorship, £5,000 prize money will be paid out on the top 8 'Order of Merit' ranking positions at the end of the season.
- 11. All entry fees are paid out in prize money.
- Group matches will be between 45 minutes and 60 minutes duration, subject to entries, and facilities available at each venue.
- 13. Knockout matches will be 90 minutes duration, except The European Open which will be 120 minutes duration.
- 14. Group matches will (normally) be played on day 1 of each event. KO matches will (normally) be played on day 2. Where facilities allow, the last 16 KO may also be played on day 1 in order to minimise overnight stays. This is subject to entries and facilities available at each event.
- 15. Formal dress must be worn at all times i.e. long sleeved shirt, waistcoat, trousers, shoes and bow tie. The acceptability of dress is at the discretion of the Tournament Director and if considered unsuitable the player may be disqualified.
- 16. Competitors are required to remain in formal dress for all publicity photographs. Competitors in the final are required to remain in formal dress, including bow tie, until prize giving and photographs are completed.
- 17. All entries must agree to wear any sponsors logos deemed applicable by the EBOS Management Team.
- 18. Players must let the Management Team know in writing at least 7 days prior to an event if they are not able to attend.
- Groups will be seeded. Seeding will be based on a cumulative ranking list used solely for this purpose.
- 20. An open unseeded draw will take place at the last 16 stage.
- 21. In addition to the EBOS subscribers, 'wildcards' will be allocated to each event by the host tournament organiser.
- Wildcard players are only permitted to play in a maximum of 2 events in one season, plus The European Open, if nominated by their NGB.
- 23. Wildcard players will not be seeded.
- Wildcard players will be eligible for prize money at the tournament only. They will not be eligible for 'Order of Merit' prize money.
- 25. Wildcard players are otherwise expected to follow the same Standard Terms & Conditions as full EBOS subscribers.
- 26. Matches from the last 16 onwards will be refereed be personnel appointed by the Tournament Director.
- Players will be expected to referee matches during the group stages.
- Parents/coaches will not be permitted to referee their own children/pupils, or vice versa.
- 29. Perpetual trophies remain the property of the host tournament promoter and/or EBOS where applicable.
- 30. If a player is not present at the match table at the stipulated

start time the match will be forfeited. Players are advised to report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes before the start time.

- Entries will only be accepted upon receipt of a completed entry form and appropriate entry fee. Entry fees are non-refundable. EBOS will deliver all information to competitors via the contact
 - details supplied on the entry form. E-mail addresses will be used as preference where supplied. EBOS will not be responsible for the receipt of this information by the competitor, who will be expected to take all reasonable steps to obtain any missing information which is thought to be due. Competitors are responsible of advising EBOS of any changes to their contact details.
- 33. The draw, format and match times will be sent out prior to each tournament. This may vary subject to entries and facilities available at each event.
- Registration on each day of play will be at 10am and play will start at 10.30am, unless otherwise notified.
- 35. The format of play shall be confirmed on the day of the competition by the Tournament Director. Amendments to the advertised format may be applied where appropriate.
- All players must agree to abide by any additional conditions imposed by each tournament venue.
- 37. Practicing will NOT be permitted at the venue prior to the first matches taking place. This applies to each day of play.
- 38. Players must behave in a manner consistent with their status as a sportsperson and their representation of EBOS, and of the game of English-Billiards.
- 39. Ungentlemanly behaviour, time wasting, and any form of bringing the game in to disrepute may result in a ranking points deduction, and/or disqualification from the tournament. A player who is considered to have consumed too much alcohol, or otherwise deemed to be unfit, may also be disqualified.
- 40. Use of mobile phones in the playing arena is not permitted. A player whose mobile phone goes off in the playing arena will be warned on the first occasion, and disqualified on the second occasion. Phones set to 'vibrate' will be treated likewise. Any texting or other use of a mobile phone during matches will also be treated as above. Turn your phone OFF.
- 41. Dates and venues may be subject to change at the discretion of the EBOS Management Team.
- 42. The EBOS is open to any player in the world. However, spaces will be limited based on facilities available at the venue, and time restraints. In addition, the EBOS committee reserves the right to refuse entry where deemed necessary.
- 43. EBOS reserves the right to change or amend these Terms & Conditions at any time. Any such changes will be advertised on our website and/or sent by email where appropriate.
- 44. Entry to EBOS tournaments will bind players to these Terms & Conditions, and in the event of any disputes arising or any other matter, the decision of the EBOS committee shall be final.

RULES AND EQUIPMENT

- All games shall be played on a standard full size English-Billiards table.
- All games shall be played with full size English-Billiards balls, of equal size and weight which conform to the current specifications.
- All games shall be played under the rules of English-Billiards as published by the World Professional Billiards & Snooker Association (WPBSA) and as ratified by the International Billiards & Snooker Federation (IBSF) - September 1995.
- This includes the following additions to the rules in line with current WPBSA guidelines:
 - i) All matches to be played with Plain Red, Yellow and White halls
 - ii) Running a Coup (playing the cue ball directly into a pocket from 'hand') is now a foul, and the usual penalties shall apply.
